About the Offline File Manager (for Microsoft Windows) Client

The Offline File Manager (for Microsoft Windows) application allows a StorNext client to perform data movement and metadata operations within the Windows Explorer interface when a relation point is created within the StorNext file system.



Note: No license key is required to use the Offline File Manager for Microsoft Windows application.

- Improved browsing for StorNext File System Pooling requests.
- · Added directory functionality for StorNext File System Pooling.
- Fixed bugs for incorrect icons, incorrect data locations, issues with SMB mounts, and other issues.

How To Download the Offline File Manager (for Microsoft Windows) Application

The Offline File Manager application for Microsoft Windows clients is packaged separately from StorNext and can be download as a standard Microsoft Windows executable (.exe) file from Quantum myStorNext (https://mystornext.guantum.com/login). Resolved Issues

SOF-226	Windows OFM 2.1.1 unable to perform tiering actions on truncated files
SOF-227	Windows OFM 2.1.1 crashes on API GW after clicking OK button without entering credentials
SOF-230	WIndows OFM 2.1.1 Offline Actions->Action Window 'Cancel' button for Move, Promote, Demote not working correctly
SOF-232	Windows OFM 2.1.1 Offline Actions->Action Window tiering buttons greyed out on directory
SOF-233	Windows OFM 2.1.1-Remove tiering actions on directory does not work
SOF-234	Windows OFM 2.1.1 Perform Tiering Operation contains Mount C:\Windows\System32\snfs1 in drop down menu
SOF-235	Windows OFM 2.1.1 files with multiple copies displays grey 'X' for icon after truncated
SOF-237	Windows OFM 2.1.1 crashes after attempting offline action on snfs2
SOF-239	Windows OFM 2.1.1 crashes if attempting tiering on files without entering API GW credentials
SOF-244	Windows OFM 2.1.1 - Unable to enter Web Service Credentials if they are not supplied in snwebsetup
SOF-245	Windows OFM 2.1.1 - Unable to perform offline/tiering actions on all files in a directory with many files using ctrl-a to select and Action Window
SOF-246	Windows OFM 2.1.1 Crashes after snwebsetup credentials re-entered
SOF-247	Windows OFM 2.1.1 Offline Actions->Action Window very slow to open on directories with many files
SOF-248	Documentation: On Windows OS, a user cannot perform an Offline File action on more than 10,000 selected files or directories at a time

Known Issues

The following are the known issues for Offline File Manager (for Microsoft Windows) 2.1.1 as well as associated workarounds, where applicable.

- In StorNext 6.3.0, if you import files from an object store storage and a UUID is not used, then the icon presented is incorrect; the icon appears as an sdisk media type instead of an object store.
- In StorNext 6.3.0, Windows clients might cause a crash if mounting or unmounting fails. This is significant to the Offline File Manager because if you use a **nss_cctl.xml** file, a client that is blocked via this central control file causes the Windows client to crash.
