Summary	Edit of filesystem via GUI loses custom changes in fstab.

Problem

Custom mount options for a StorNext file system in /etc/fstab can be overwritten when changing the file system configuration from the GUI. Mount options set by the GUI such as proxy are not affected.

The problem can be caused by doing the following:

- 1 From the StorNext GUI, click:
 Configuration > File Systems > Edit
- 2 Click Apply.

Symptoms

Examine the /etc/fstab file. You might notice missing mount options.

If custom mount options were configured to improve performance, performance degradation may be another symptom of the problem.

Solution

This issue was addressed in StorNext 4.2.2. The GUI will not update the /etc/fstab file when the edit action is used.

Workaround

Make a copy of /etc/fstab prior to changing the system configuration in the StorNext GUI. Make the necessary configuration modifications in the StorNext

GUI and save changes. After editing the fstab file, restore the /etc/fstab file from the copy.
