Product	StorNext® All Storage Manager Versions
Summary	An MDC which is dedicated to StorNext with no other applications present encounters a persistent reservation placed on a tape drive by a non-StorNext application thus preventing StorNext from using the drive.

Problem

Tape Drives reserved by a non-StorNext application are preventing StorNext from utilizing the drive.

Symptoms

SNSM operations show tape drives go offline and StorNext logs report reservation conflicts.

Note: Using “fs_scsi utility” to check the persistent reservation conflict, shows a non-StorNext reservation key.

Solution

Since StorNext MDCs are the only hosts with access to the tape drives, add entries in the `/etc/modprobe.d/blacklist.conf` file to blacklist the `st`, `ch`, and `osst` driver. This prevents them from reloading after a reboot.

On the secondary MDC of the HA pair:

- 1 Using your file editor of choice, open:
`/etc/modprobe.d/blacklist.conf`

a Add the following lines:

```
# These drivers are blacklisted to prevent a tape drive  
# persistent reservation conflict with StorNext.
```

```
blacklist st
```

```
blacklist ch
```

```
blacklist osst
```

2 Check to see if the st, ch or osst modules are loaded.

```
lsmod | grep -E "^st|^ch|^osst"
```

3 Remove the modules listed (i.e.):

```
rmmmod st
```

```
rmmmod ch
```

```
rmmmod osst
```

Complete steps 1-3 on the primary MDC of the HA pair.
